- A set uniform makes life easier for parents.
- The school uniform will be much cheaper than brand name clothing.
- A uniform improves public impressions of the school.
- Students wearing a uniform improves safety on excursions.
- A uniform helps ensure that students are appropriately dressed.
- Wearing a uniform helps students prepare for the workplace.
- A school uniform helps develop a school identity and increase school pride.

The implementation of a Student Dress Code was a key step forward for the school to enhance and complement the school environment. The following is the College's dress code:

- Dark blue hat of any style. (To be worn by students when they are outside in Term 1 and Term 4).
- Dark blue windcheater with light blue emblem
- Light blue or white polo top.
- Dark blue or grey trousers with elasticised waist with drawstring. Tracksuit pants are also to be option.
- Dark blue or grey shorts/skirt of same style as trousers.
- Blue and white school check dress.
- Grey, white or dark blue socks.
- Appropriate footwear includes plain boots, runners, sandals and school shoes. Thongs, slippers, gum boots, high heel shoes, open slip on shoes are not appropriate.
